Geography

We will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify countries, continents and oceans of the world.

We will use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes on a map.

Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length and height. Compare and order lengths.

Use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement.
