## Mathematics

### We will be learning to:

- Match objects
- Find a pair

- Identify a set
- Sort objects by their type
- Compare amounts using words 'more' and 'fewer'
- Learn numbers 1,2,3 and explore their composition
- Link symbols to the number value

## Understanding the World

### We will learn:

- That transport helps us to get to different places
- How people can use transport
- How different vehicles move
- We will learn key words including; driver, passenger, journey, engine and vehicle.
- It is important to stay safe around roads and vehicles.
- What transport is available in our local environment.

## Expressive Arts and Design

### We will learn:

- To us paint to make track marks on paper

- To build and construct using a design.
