Super Hero Day!

Children will come dressed as a super hero or real life hero and will meet heroes such as nurses, paramedics and firefighters.

Religious Education

We will be exploring the questions, 'Who is Jewish?' and 'How do they live?'

PE

We will be developing teamwork skills, athletics and practising for sports day.

Science

To distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.

To identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.

To describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.

To compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

Music

Our unit this term is called 'Your Imagination'.

We will be learning and performing the song with a percussion accompaniment.

Art and Design Technology

To develop drawing skills and practise techniques.

To explore drawing materials and surfaces.

To be inspired by drawings others have made.

Computing

In our unit 'Grouping data' we will be learning about sorting and labelling objects into different groups and learning how to answer questions about data.

History and Geography

We will be learning about significant people from history including: Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole.

We will be comparing what hospitals were like before and after Florence Nightingale; learning the important changes she made.

We will be learning about where they came from and where in the world they helped the soldiers.

PHSE

Our SCARF unit this term is called 'Doing My Best!'

We will be learning about keeping our selves healthy and developing resilience.

Mathematics

Multiplication and division:

To solve one-step problems using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher.

Fractions:

To recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

To recognise, find and name a quarter as 1 of 4 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

English

To write a fact-file about real life superheroes (significant nurses in history).

To write an innovated story inspired by the text 'Supertato'.

To use the text 'Traction Man' to create a comic strip.
