Music

Computing

Science

To identify and name wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.

To observe changes, as plants grow throughout Spring.

To identify and describe basic structure of flowering plants, including trees.

Mathematics

Multiplication and division:

To solve one-step problems using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher.

Fractions:

To recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

To recognise, find and name a quarter as 1 of 4 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

Position and direction

To describe turns, position, and to use ordinal numbers.

English

To form lower-case and capital letters correctly.

To punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop.

To read and spell words accurately, that contain GPCs that have been taught.

To write a letter applying skills and knowledge taught.

To write a character description.
