Clubs Autumn Term 2023

If your child is interested in attending one of our after school clubs, please complete our online form https://forms.office.com/e/xYq3HZcEww by 12 noon on Tuesday 19th February. Regardless of the number of clubs they attend, clubs will have a one-off charge of £4 per child, unless your child is in receipt of free school meals (not universal infant free school meals) or they are classed a service child. Please do not send any money now. Places will be allocated and then a club charge will be added to your ParentPay account at a later date (please remember that we are unable to take cash payments).

We will try to ensure that ALL children have at least one club they have chosen and then we will allocate additional places as they are available. (No clubs for Reception children while they settle into their first year of school).

Clubs will run from 3:15pm - 4:15pm on the following weeks:-

25th September, 2nd October, 9th October, 16th October, 30th October, 6th November, 13th November.

Penalty Notice Warning

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.


