### Clubs Autumn Term 2023

Regardless of the number of clubs they attend, clubs will have a one-off charge of £4 per child, unless your child is in receipt of free school meals (not universal infant free school meals) or they are classed a service child. Please do not send any money now. Places will be allocated and then a club charge will be added to your ParentPay account at a later date (please remember that we are unable to take cash payments).

We will try to ensure that **ALL** children have at least one club they have chosen and then we will allocate additional places as they are available. (No clubs for Reception children while they settle into their first year of school).

### Penalty Notice Warning

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.

Aspens, our catering supplier would like to inform parents; From data collection by our units over a period of a few months it has been found that over 80% of food waste in our primary schools is jacket potato skins. Based on this data the food team ran experiments finding that pupils receive and eat a higher potato content in a larger potato(40) than that of a smaller whole potato previously supplied(80), thus the pupil eating more and wasting less if they are not eating the skin (which most do not). The correct pupil portion supplied is with half a 40 instead of a whole 80 and it contains 2 x protein.

Below is an example of the selection of puddings and salad available daily from our kitchen.

Along with our jacket potatoes and pasta options, it certainly is a difficult choice!

### 1 Decide on your preferred schools

You are strongly advised to name **three** preferences on the application form. Naming a second or third preference does not give you any less chance of getting a place at your preferred school. When making your decision you should...

...think about how your child will get to school. Go to [www.cornwall.gov.uk/schooltransport](http://www.cornwall.gov.uk/schooltransport) for more information on whether your child would be entitled to home to school travel assistance.

...look at the admission arrangements on our website that will be used to allocate places for each school.

...consider naming your nearest or designated school as one of your preferences. You can find your nearest or designated school on our website.

...look at the detailed admissions information on our website, also available on request.

### 2 Submit your application by 31 October 2023

### 3 Wait to find out which school you have been allocated

If you applied on time you will be notified of your allocation on **National Offer Day: 1 March 2024. Apply on time!** Late applications will only be dealt with after National Offer Day and there may not be any places left at your preferred schools.
