### MMR Information

Following recent cases of Measles throughout the UK, The UK Health Security Agency's (UKHSA) warns the virus can spread very easily among those who are unvaccinated, especially in nurseries and schools. Measles can be a very serious disease, leading to ear and chest infections, fits, diarrhoea, and damage to the brain. Measles usually starts with cold like symptoms followed by a rash.
