

Religious Education

We will be exploring the religion of Christianity.

We will be learning about Incarnation and why Christmas is important to Christians.

We will also learn about thankfulness.

Art and Design

Textiles - We will be designing and making fabric Christmas decorations.

Art - We will be going on a drawing journey to improve our sketching skills.

Computing

Computer systems and networks: We will be developing our understanding of IT and its uses in the world around us and how it can be used safely.

P.E

Ball skills- dribbling, passing and developing our gross motor skills.

Dance - responding to stimuli through movement and to create sequences of movement.

Enrichment (Seasonal, visits and 'wow' moments)

In school, we will be having a 'Christmas performance' where the children will take part in a school nativity.

English (including Punctuation, Spelling and Grammar)

In English we will be exploring our topic of seasons through writing a non-chronological report and persuasive letters influenced by high quality stories such as 'Tree' and 'A Walk in the Woods'.

We will discuss and explore a range of stories, identifying new vocabulary which we can then use in our independent writing.

We will explore the Year 1 and 2 spelling rules and continue to apply these into our writing.



Why Do We Have Different Types of Weather?

History and Geography

We will be looking at remembrance and why this is important.

We will be learning the four countries of the UK.

Understand that weather changes depending on the season.

To learn the different continents of the world.

Learn how to measure and record different weather over a period of time.

Mathematics

To count, recognise and compare numbers to 50 and to say one more and one less than a given number.

To count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 (Year 2, multiples of 3 also).

To learn the multiplication symbol.

To make and recognise equal groups.

To count out money using pounds and pence.

Music

Learn the song 'Ho Ho Ho' and other songs with a festive theme.

Listen to and appraise different songs.

To find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Carry out investigations by observing, measuring and recording observations.
