

Indian Queens School Parliament 2024-2025

18/9/2024 – MPs voted for and badge colour agreed – gold and blue.

2/10/2024 – Badges awarded and talked about Ministries – Milly (Health and safety), Jack (Playgrounds), Sennen (Traffic), Eddie (Behaviour), Taylor (Assemblies and events) and Julia (Environment).

9/10/2024 – Health and safety ok so far – some people sitting on fence and noticed rocking on chairs. Behaviour – Listening and being helpful improving but concerned but rude words and not getting work completed in the lesson. Playgrounds – some games too rough. Traffic – not looking when crossing the road. Talking in assembly becoming an issue. No environmental issues – some going into Faraway Forest without adults. Dropping food in the lunch hall.

Petition forms – Whole afternoon of TTRS. Siblings to visit this school. Toy days – possible damage.

17/10/2024 – Joey has joined representing Tintagel Class. Health and Safety people to come in for training. Talked about disco. Noise levels on school trip buses. New bike rack being used a lot. Leaning back on chairs. Football zip ties applied.

24/10/2024 – Listening improved. People still climbing on posts when they're slippy. Respectful in toilets – talk to school – locks. Getting muddy – avoid sliding on the grass. No going round the block. Would like to use OEA more – possible open at break time. Barrel rolling – ok with adult. Bit of swearing starting. Dares. Parents should park in the car park. Develop quiet reading area behind the Lab. Fungi assembly. Go to KS1 classes to collect ideas. Areas you can and can't go in.

8/11/2024 – Preparing clipboards for KS1 classes. Gathering ideas. Talked about what could be better about the school. Some people being too rough at break time. Less people talking in assembly. Health and Safety – people sitting on the fence. Environment – screaming in the toilet. Playgrounds ok – mud issues – close areas? Y5/6 gate blocked by cars making crossing difficult – Mrs Law message. KS1 suggestions – like friends, like outside, wanted more learning and a bigger playground. Wants more play things like in Rec class. Fistral like lunch and teachers. More busy learning, paddling pool, slide and bigger grass area.

12/11/2024 – Poppy remembrance generally well respected. Ideas for the future – purple poppies, outline of a dog – liked using plywood shapes. Sewing poppies inside – need to be weatherproof.

19/11/2024 – Christmas disco difficult to do as a busy time of year. Singing assembly – not everyone sings. Increase in mud – ban grassy areas for a bit – possible use of other gate. Leaving rubbish – possible litter competition poster. Lots like the climbing tree. Bit of hiding in bushes – breaking sticks off trees. Physical contact at times but generally ok.

Safety ok. Forms – carpet for certain classes – spilled drinks, art resources dropped?
Cheese bean wrap is back on the menu. Spoke about Parliament Day.

27/11/2024 – Talked about missed County Hall Day and how it will be rescheduled for March. Spoke about Health and Safety coming in soon. Reviewed petitions and received reports. Outlined Christmas activities.

10/12/2024 – Health and Safety team came in to give training to School Parliament. Detailed how to address issues around the school.

17/12/2024 – Schools MPs went to KS1 classes for discussions and ideas. Feed back what the School Parliament have been doing.

07/01/2025 – Fistril: Liked a ball pi, a bigger playground, slide – talked about dangerous ideas and limitations at school. Hemmick/Gwithian – Like ‘Busy Learning’ – liked the idea of different groups doing different things, would like a bigger playground. Need to remind to look after equipment. Polzeath – Very sensible, like ‘Busy Learning’, more art activities. Transport ok – Drang cut through closed – would like to open up route again – understand health and safety issues. Jewellery issues. Reminders for PE kits. Assembly – talk when stand up. Swearing at break time – toilet use. Muddy conditions. Unsafe areas – ramp use ok, no playing there. Spot checks on library.

17/01/2025 – Safety Reps – all names to be sent. JG Environment – increase in litter, access to Faraway Forest, litter finders from Y6. Frozen pond – throwing items to break the ice. Mud slippery. JW Playground – on the grass too much, balls kicked over. Possible golf ball driving range 4 – 2 vote for. TC Assemblies – too much turning round in assemblies, petitions forms getting a bit silly. JF – Generally ok, could have more walking to school. JRSOs stop sign competition. EG Behaviour – boy behaviour improving, rough play assembly, running in corridor until they see a teacher, blutac taken from posters. MW Health and Safety – sickness/disease – handwashing, concerns about poisonous mushrooms. Talked about importance of swimming in schools.

1/2/2025 – Ofsted inspections – really nice and kind. Asked about what School Parliament like about the school, bullying, good school, feel safe etc. Saw them around the school lots.

13/2/2025 – Things to address in Parliament Assembly. Talking in assemblies – listening skills. Transport – lots of parking in front of school, some cars not well parked, blocked in at times. Basketballs being used as footballs, footballers use all the playground. Health and safety – using skipping ropes to whip each other. Increase in litter – possible litter competition poster design. Mud – knee sliding. OEA – volunteering for help, would like to use more. School uniform. Making glue-tak. Try to balance negatives with positives.

28/2/2025 – Talked about County Hall Day with Y5/6. Expectations – giving out letters.

4/3/2025 – Parking at the car park – no spaces left. Don't want to lose field space so encourage parents to park sensibly. Drang open – much better. Assembly – whispering when lead teacher looks away. Pond – frogspawn – litter a problem in the pond. Would like the pond open – would like OEA and Faraway Forest open for breaks? Look into owl boxes. Behaviour – improving, need to look after school equipment – sand timer, snapped ankle skippers and knots in skipping ropes.

7/3/2025 – Parliament Day at County Hall. All enjoyed the day.

19/3/2025 – Easter competition – no littering competition photocopy winners to go around the school. People sitting on the fence and it's folding over – idea for Mr Norton. Soap in girls toilets. Outdoor Area is open more often – possible Y1/2 coming to the OAE. Miss Rundle – fave subject maths, like playground and reading, equipment and pond.

Meetings not held due to camps.

13/5/2025 – Long petition about the possibility of 'Seconds' at lunch. MPs to talk to the kitchen. Talked about Health and safety Day at Tregolls. Everyone getting along better – wanting to have fun – more space is good. Idea for safety rule posters around school. Litter on increase with more litter pickers 'Well done litter pick stickers'. Outdoor Education Area – building bases, not letting others in. Transport ok. Fence by lab – balls going.

11/6/2025 – Arranging Health and Safety Day.

18/6/2025 – Health and Safety Day at Tregolls.

27/6/2025 – Talked about petition forms. Fair and sports day events coming up.

11/7/2025 – Raised lots of money at the fair – Y6 stalls did well. Y6 paying attention to stalls. Sweet wrappers for litter – not enough bins. Older teenagers being difficult. Children playing with books during assembly. Parking generally ok. Inform police of anti-social behaviour. Baby chicks being found out of nests. Panic about snakes – really just crickets. Groups not kind to animals – address in an assembly. Balls being lost. Golf as a possible break time activity. Sports day – event shelter like a beach umbrella.
